Materials List for Beginning Painting:

For paint colors, both will need:

- Alizarin or Rose, <u>PLUS</u> Cad Red Light
- Pthalo Blue PLUS Ultramarine Blue
- Cad Yellow Medium PLUS Cad Lemon
- BURNT Umber
- Large tube of Titanium White

Disposable Palette

Sketchbook and pencils or pen

Accuview Viewfinder (optional, but recommend)

Multiple canvases or boards for each day, 8x0 - 16x20 (Blick has a huge sale on packs of them right now)

Apron

Tape if you are using canvas paper

Brushes (at least 3 flat brushes, a 2-4 size, a 6-8 size and a 10-12 size, better quality ones will stay in shape and not lose hair on your canvas) I use Princeton 6300, or Silver Bristlon, but I wouldn't go for Rosemary Brushes or Kolinsky Sables for class (too expensive).

Oil Painters:

- Gamsol mineral spirits and a covered container (not tiny) for it
- Larger jar to dump the day's gamsol in so it will be separated out for your next painting session
- Please do not bring Liquin. If you need a medium because you paint is dry and thick, just get some Cold Pressed Linseed oil

Acrylic Painters:

- Container (like a big deli container) for water
- Spray bottle to keep paint moist

Yes you can get most of these at Michaels, but I would seriously recommend you get to an Art Store like Blick in Boston. It is cheaper and they actually have everything and there are artists working there if you have questions. If you know what you are looking for, their website is good, and delivery is usually 3-5 business days.
