Supply list

- 1. Panels or Canvas
 - a. One 14 x 11 or 16 x 20
 - b. I use Ampersand Hardboards that I gesso with Liquitex. I give it 3 coats, using a foam roller and 2-3 inch bristle brush from the hardware store. I use the brush to smooth down the ridges and bumps produced by the roller (do not add Liquitex to brush, just use it to smooth down the ridges). I do that after every coat. And with a palette knife sand it down or scrape off any speck before each coat.
 - c. Please refrain from using a poor canvas as it will affect the results.
- 2. Brushes and Knives
 - a. Filbert Bristles 3, 2, 1 (Buy 2-3 sets of each)
 - b. Round Bristles 3, 2, 1
 - c. Round Sables 1-0
 - d. 1-2 palette knives
 - e. I highly recommend you buy new brushes or use the newest brushes at your disposal. The poorer the brush, the poorer the results.
- 3. Colors Rembrandt brand
 - a. Ultramarine blue or Cobalt blue
 - b. Alizarin Crimson
 - c. Ivory black
 - d. Viridian
 - e. Transparent Oxide Brown
